

DIAMOND REGIONAL SEWER LIFT STATION AND DUAL FORCE MAINS PROJECT UPDATE

Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District (EVMWD) recently began construction for the Diamond Regional Sewer Lift Station and Dual Force Mains Project. The project involves construction of a sewer lift station and approximately 3,400 linear feet of new, parallel sewer pipelines (force mains). Construction began in October 2024 and is anticipated to be completed by October 2026.

Project highlights include:

Sewer Lift Station

- Dewatering system installed
- Sheet shorting/tie backs/bracing being installed
- Excavation for structure underway

Dual Force Mains

- 26" and 18" dual force mains 80%installed in Diamond Circle
- Microtunneling under San Jacinto River starting mid-January.
